## Synopsis:

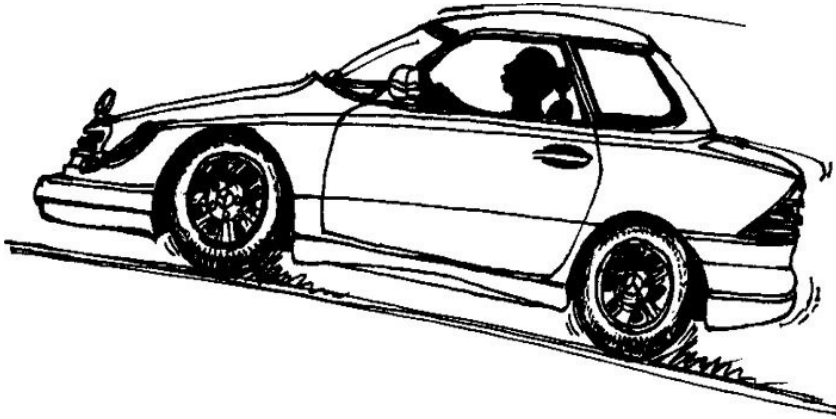
This story is about an accident that a boy saw happen. He explains where they were when it all happened.

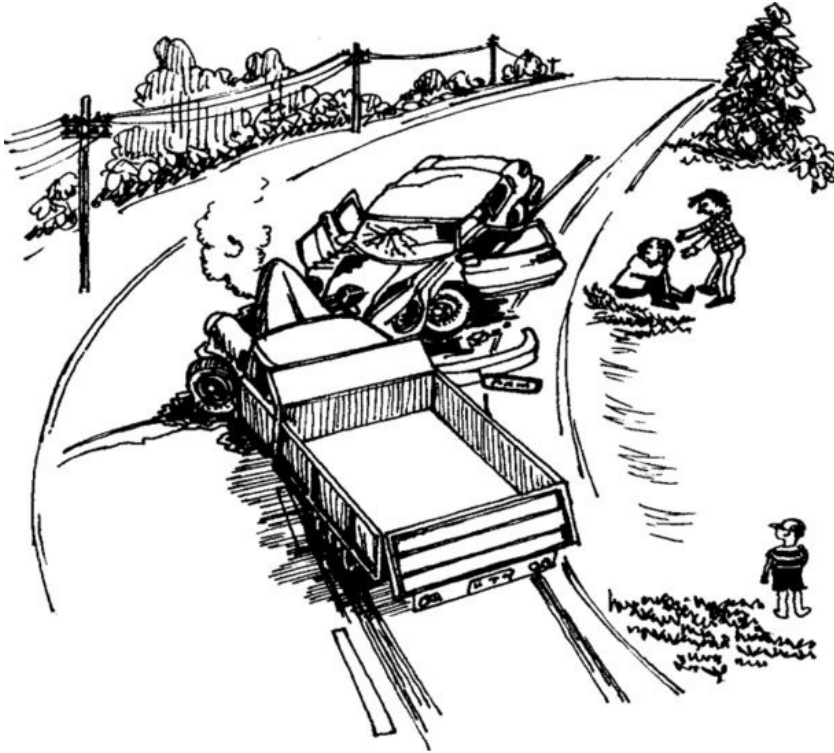

accident.

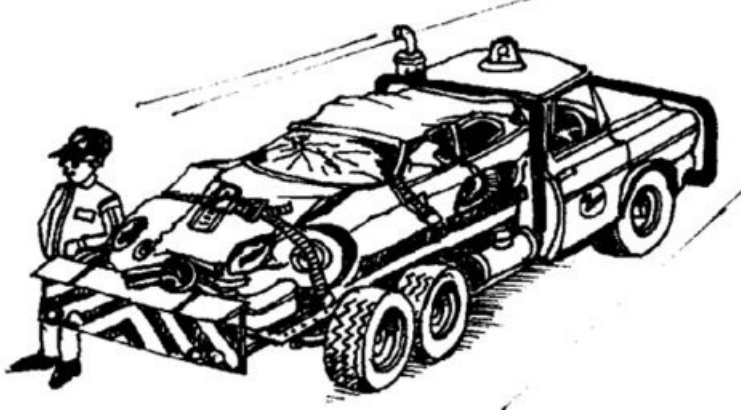
