"Thank you," said Mouse.

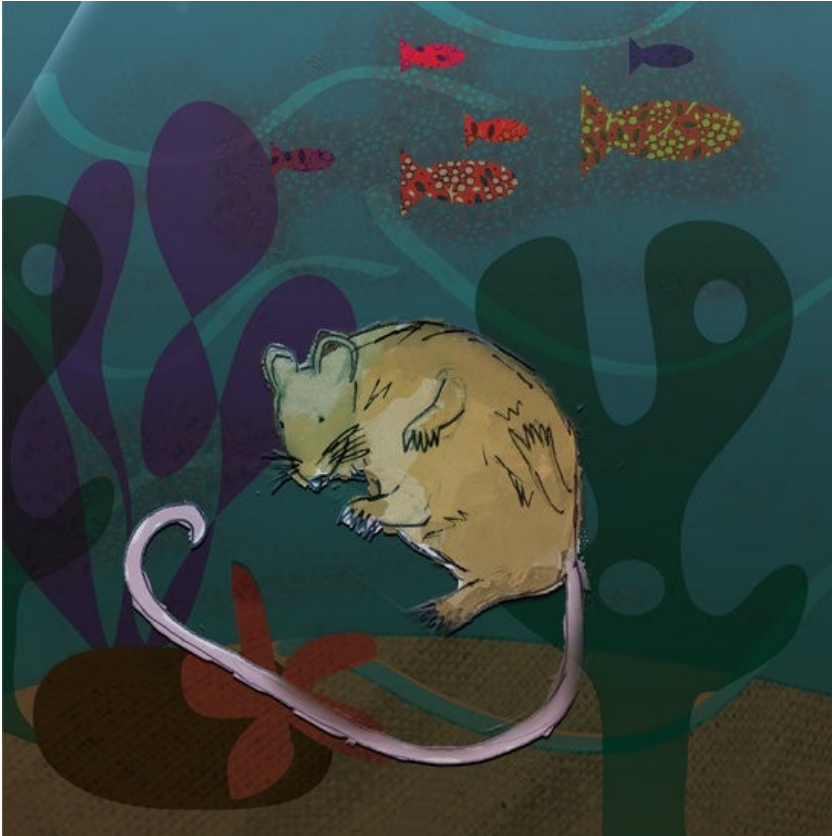




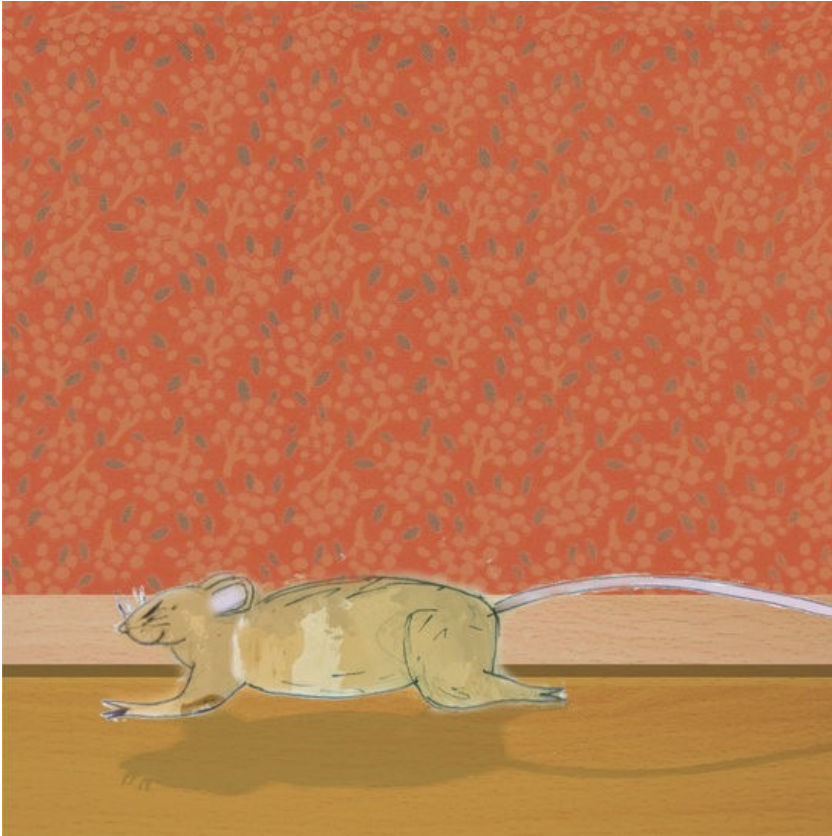
That night, Mouse's

dreams were cold and wet.

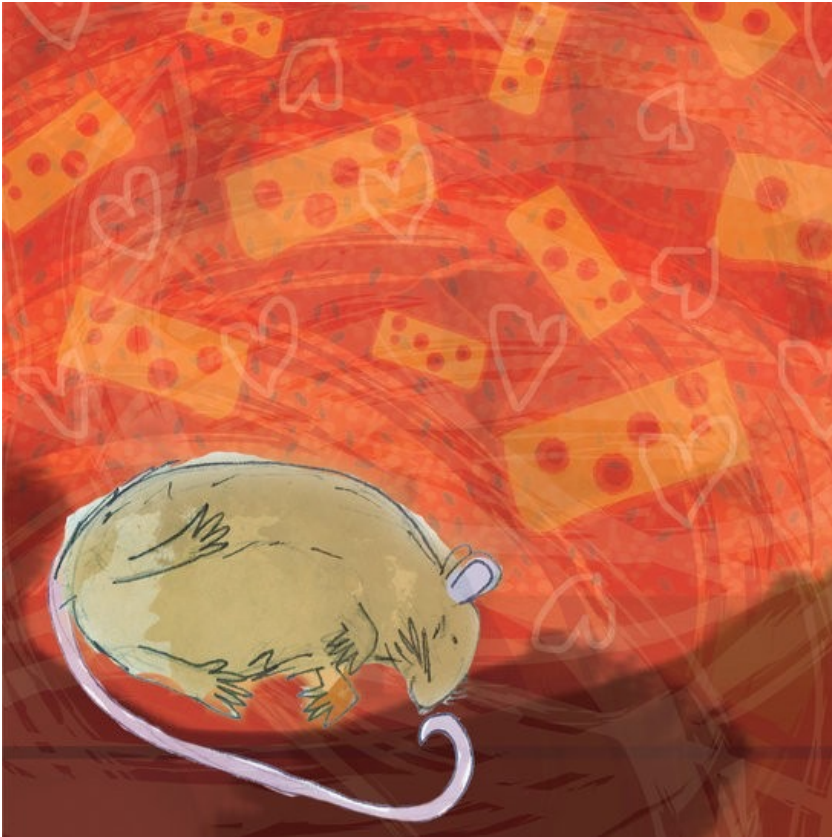


Mouse needed somewhere warm and dry.
