

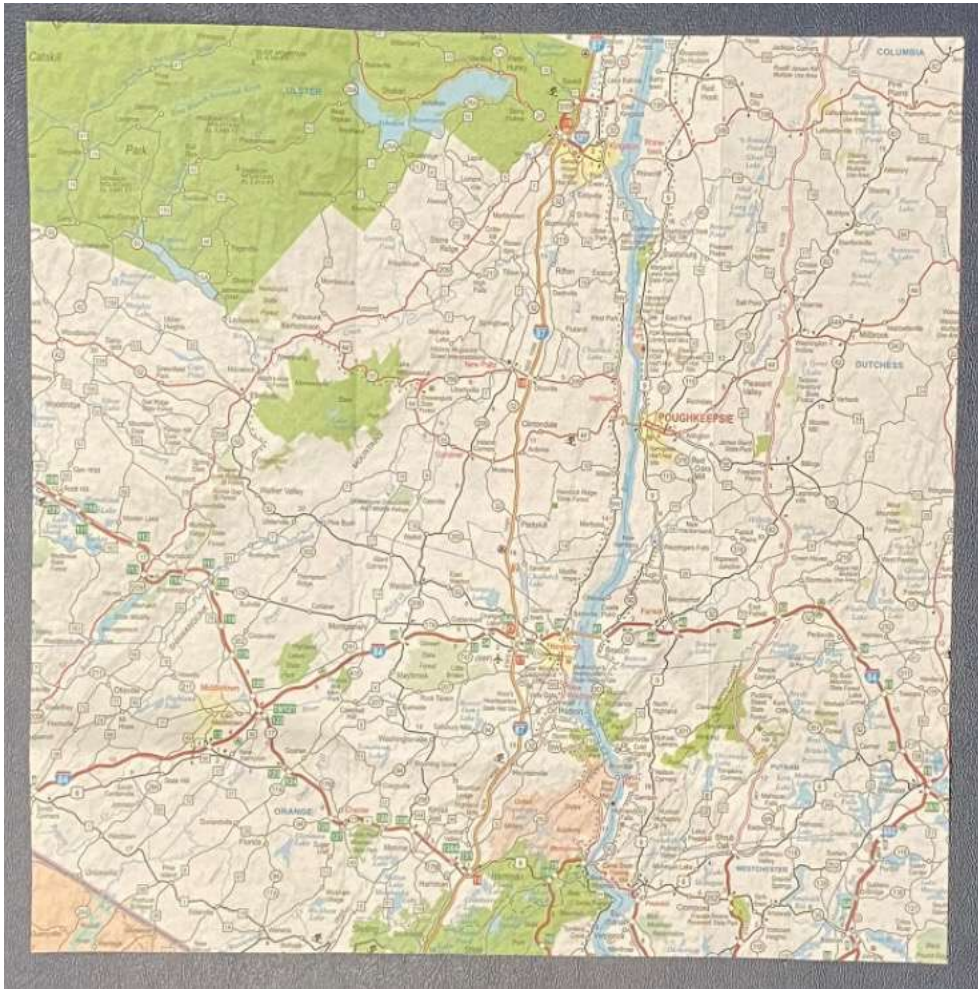
Joint service project using old maps

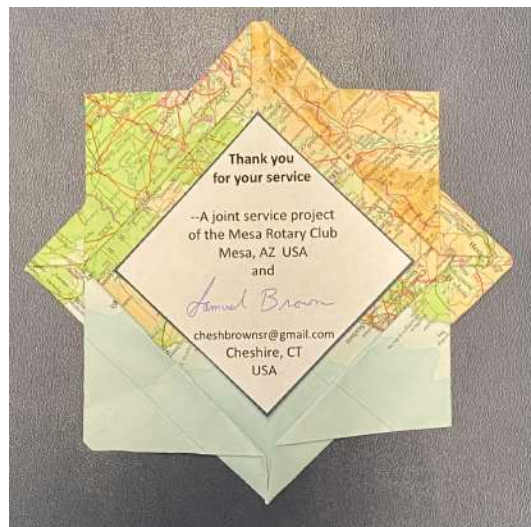

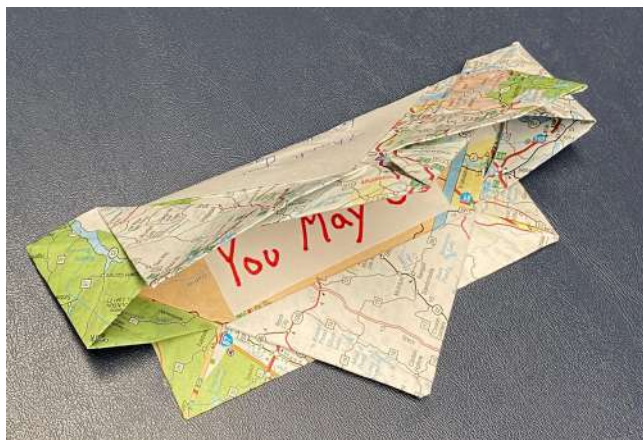

The 9 ½ inch squares are folded into origami frames. The 3 inch squares are placed on the front and back of the frame.



And then folded in half to make it easier for shipment



The final step is packing the folded frames into a box where they will be included in care packages for service men and women stationed around the world.
