Mary sent a letter to Sue, a person she knew at their place of work.



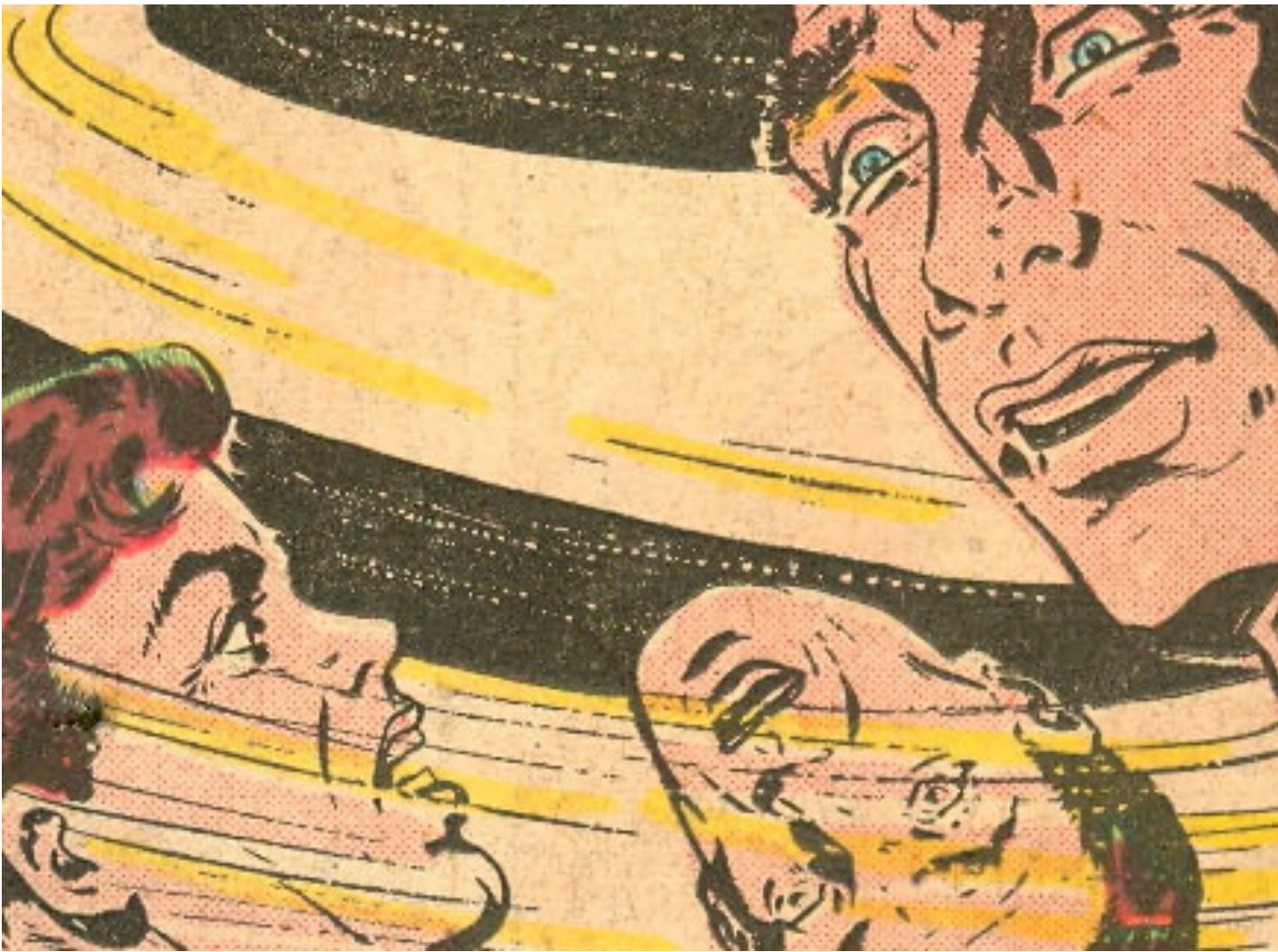
Sue read the letter at the office: “I saw you looking at Dave at work—he is mine! Beware!!!”

As he took out the letter, he noticed a familiar smell.

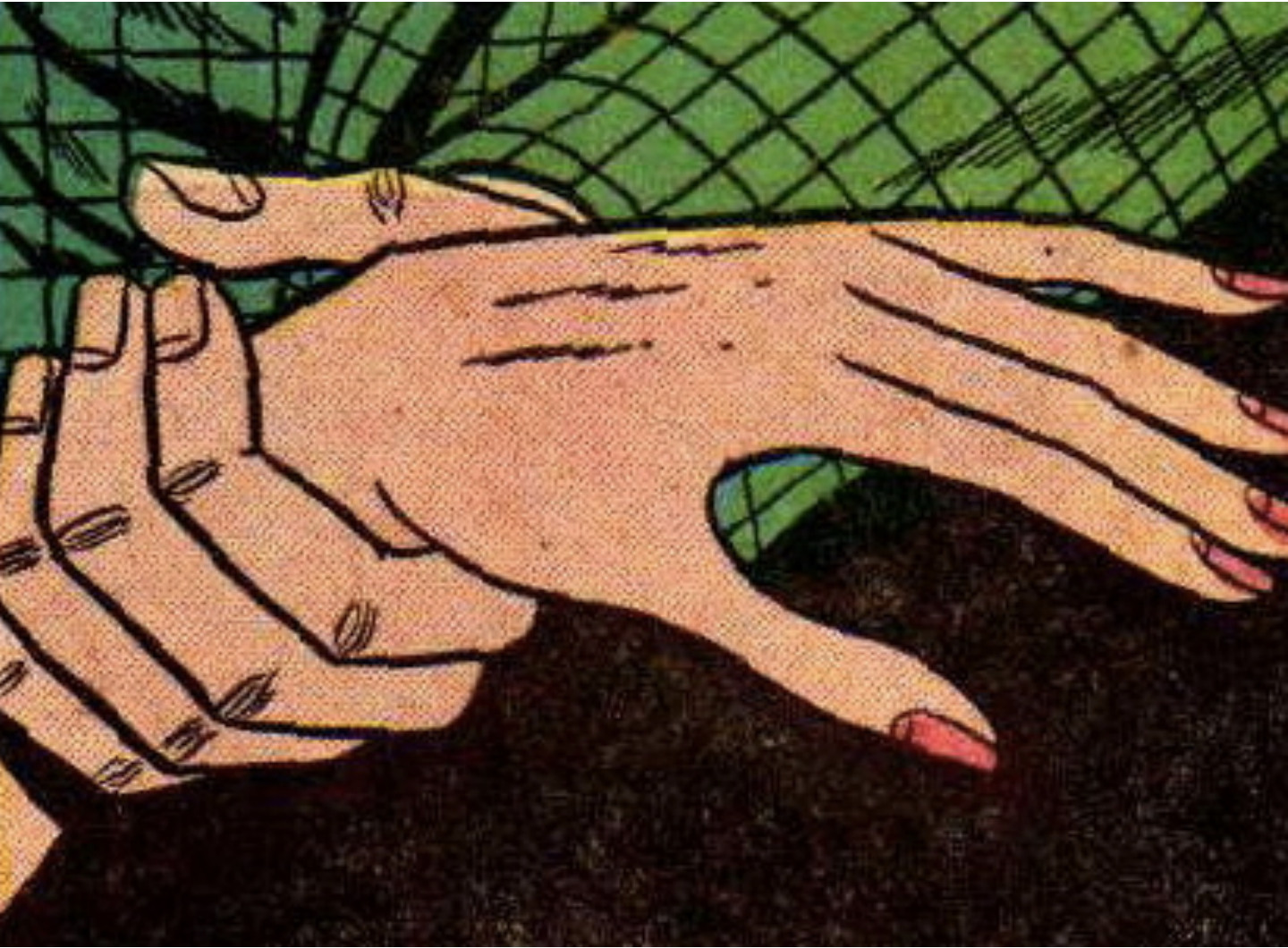


He recognized Mary's perfume and set out to stop her.

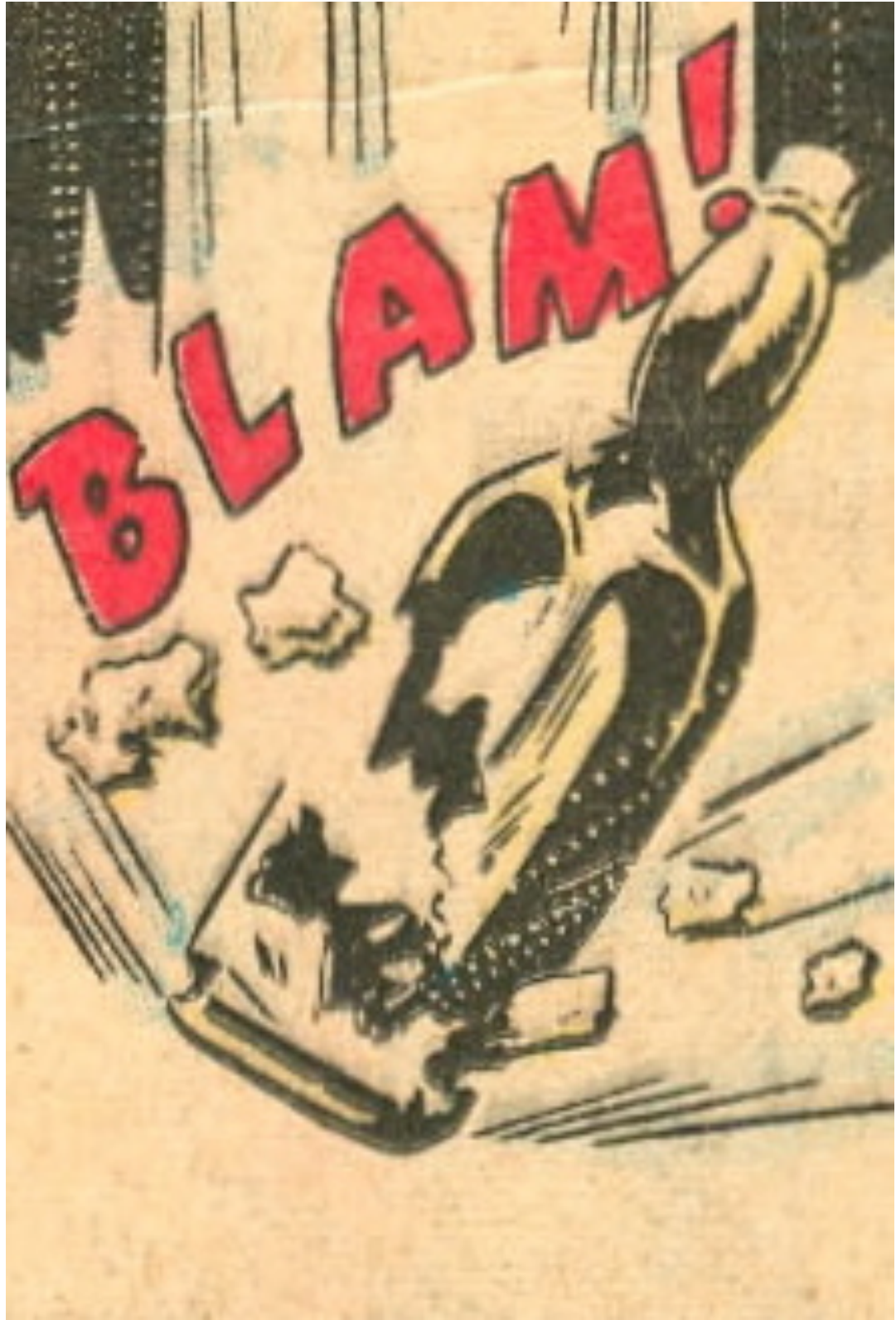


At that moment Mary was putting poison in Sue's water glass.
